Event Information

Order of Events

Teams/Show twirl/Rhythmic, Modeling/Best Appearing, Basic/Military, Strut, Solo and Multiple Baton, Pageant Awards

Miss Winterfest Pageant

Athletes compete in Costume Modeling 20%, Strut (**X OR USTA**) 40% and Solo 40%. All will model in costume. Open to all ability levels and solo determines division.

Winterfest Basic Skills Pageant

Athletes compete in Costume Modeling (**no interview**) in costume 20%, Basic strut 40%, and Solo 40%. Solo determines ability level, and this event is only open to **Novice** twirlers.

Winterfest Strut Queen

Athletes in all divisions Model (**no interview**) in costume and compete in Basic March and Military. If you are in Adv. Basic or Adv. Military, you must compete in Advanced Strut Queen.

Special Novice Solo

Open to all who have never won a first in any solo event, regardless of affiliation. Win does not count towards advancement.

Trio – Age Groups

Primary: Members are an average age of 9.99

Juvenile: Members are an average age of 10-13.99

Junior: Members are an average age of 14-17.99

Senior: Members are an average age of 18+

Winterfest All-Around

- Beg. and Int. Athletes will compete in Dance twirl (same music for all), Solo and Two Baton.
- Advanced Athletes will compete in Freestyle, Solo and Multiple Baton

Placement points for each event will determine overall placement.

Individual Event Ages

Age groups based on your age as of 9/1/23 and will be divided into the following divisions:

0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16+.

Each age division will also be divided into skill levels.

Due to being an unsanctioned contest, we ask that you compete the same level as your current twirling organization.

Uncontested Events/Advancement
